

Pringles Tin Pencil Pot / Money Box



Introduction

For this project you require a small Pringles tin which should be rinsed and dried. If making a money box you will require the lid too; get an adult to cut a coin sized slit in the top. The project involves decorating a rectangular template, cutting it out and sticking it around the tin.

Note: before proceeding, print a blank template and check that it fits perfectly. The template is sized for a default screen resolution of 96dpi.

Method

1. Open the template for this project.
2. If the template appears with scroll bars, then double click on its title bar to make sure that the whole rectangle is visible.
3. Decorate the rectangle. You can use colour magic's stamps or import your own images and photographs. Try not to remove the borders of the rectangle.
4. Print your design in **landscape** mode.
5. Cut out the design.
6. Cut out a piece of clear contact paper (sticky back plastic) and cover the design.
7. Cover the Pringles tin with paper glue and apply your design.

Hint: when cutting out, leave a small rectangular flap at one end. You will get a neater finish if you overlap the two ends of your design.
